

Testing for heavy metals and pesticides in products manufactured for TruColostrum[®]

Product(s): Bovine Dried Colostrum

Trade Name: TruColostrum[®]

TruColostrum[®] ingredients are regulated by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), National Animal Supplements Council (NASC), Low Risk Veterinary Health Products (LRVHP), and the Natural and Non-Prescription Health Products (NNHPD) division of Health Canada. TruColostrum[®] ingredients are produced in GMP, HACCP, GMP+ and FSA certified facilities.

The colostrum ingredient used for the manufacture of TruColostrum[®] is sourced from licensed USDA Grade A dairy farms that provide milk for human consumption.

As part of its quality assurance program, every batch of TruColostrum[®] products undergoes comprehensive testing and evaluation at the processing plant. Part of this program involves the monitoring of products for the presence of heavy metals and pesticides. These tests are conducted by accredited third party laboratories using approved methods.

This letter is to certify that the levels of heavy metals and pesticides in the bovine dried colostrum products manufactured for TruColostrum[®] are below the maximum residue limits (MRL's) for food.
